This summer camp is a further step in the community movement towards a more conscious society with more profound values and deeper relationships. The camp will give you the opportunity to become familiar with similar and differing visions and the chance to exchange experiences and ideas with others. It is meant to strengthen us in our lives as a part of our communities and provide interested participants with the opportunity of getting to know each other.

The young people from the Tribe of the Likatier cordially invite you to the Community Summer Camp YOUTH IN COMMUNITY 2010. Together we will experience a large-scale and intensive summer camp. We have been organising summer camps for young people for many years now. Again and again we have experienced how this time together provides us all with valuable impulses and influences us on a long-term basis. In this camp we would like to create a place where you can present your visions, your communities and your goals. Let us form a network which is strong and stable, a net which has the power to change the world a bit.

We would be pleased, if your community also supported this idea so that you could take part in the first large-scale community summer camp for the younger generation.



Goal and Vision of the Summer Camp

We want to create a place full of exchange, friendship and love, and thus take a step together towards an unconventional, lively and sustainable way of life. Our main focus is to aim for creating a network of communities, getting to know the common and different visions and goals. We would like to learn and grow through the experiences which young people have through their positions in their communities.

The camp is meant to be a platform for common exploration and learning, for questions and answers, for an exchange of information and experiences that creates new perspectives for all of us. By getting together we can give each other the chance to get to know our culture and our way of living communally. At the same time we make

new friends and deepen our relationships with others of like mind. This strengthens us in our passion for community living and for life itself.

What goes on at the Camp?

Young people from different communities get together and exchange their experiences. Getting to know these communities is, of course, the main focus. How do we love, what are our relationships like, who heads the community and how is everything organised? All this takes place not only theoretically or academically; we get to know each other through exercises, games, working together and other typical community activities.

Together we form a network of the younger generation at the camp. We seek synergies, create a platform for education, experiences and work. What needs to be changed in society and how can communities contribute? What do we want to achieve and influence? What is the role we young people play in our community and in the community movement on a world-wide scale? We ask questions that are decisive for our lives and we seek the answers together.

Why is this good for communities?

We are all growing on a personal level and strengthening our identification with our own community by gaining friends of like mind and forming a network for young people who share similar visions: by getting to know and explore new ways of life that we can learn from, by spending time intensifying friendships and by getting close to each other.

In addition, each community has the opportunity to introduce itself to a group of interested young people and win them over for their own visions, for co-operation, etc. In any case, we can definitely learn a lot from each other and profit from such an encounter.



Who are we?

Our Community - The Tribe of the Likatier

The Tribe of the Likatier was founded 35 years ago. In the meantime, over 200 children, young people and adults live here in Füssen in our new-age tribe. We have strong roots in this area and with each other as well. Having deep relationships with each other is important to us. In the tribe we want to create a home where we feel loved and secure. The core of the Tribe has decided to stay together permanently and continue to develop it. We are working on becoming completely self-sufficient. We spend a lot of time working on being lively and authentic, both on a cultural and on a spiritual level. We are aiming for a matriarchal form of relationships and attitude to-

wards the world, beginning with the yin principles of receptivity and creating a basis for life, as opposed to the competitive, excluding principles of patriarchy that dominate in our society. It is our goal to develop our own authentic culture, whose purpose is, above all, to further the life and liveliness of all tribal members.

The Youth-Group - The NewComers

Our youth group consists of about 50 young people between the ages of 14 and 30. The majority of us live in the center of the Tribe of the Likatier and are very intensively involved with the visions and goals of the Tribe. We want to become more natural, learn to love genuinely, and be able to form stable, warm relationships. Especially young people from intentional communities are welcome in this camp. Of course, other young people who are interested in communities and alternative new ways of life and are between the ages of 16 and 30 are also welcome.

Exceptions are principally possible.

Location, Information on Daily Life

We will be spending 12 days in the out-of-doors. We will sleep in tents or on a group mat. The showers are out in the open. The cooking is vegetarian. We can comply with special requests for vegan or raw vegetables. We cook mainly biological food, some of which comes directly from our fields and farm.

Finally we found the venue. We are very happy to have this piece of land near Marktoberdorf in Bavaria that simply has everything we need. An adjacent forest, a huge meadow and a river that flows by it directly. You can find all new informations on the website.
